- Black lace-up leather or leather-substitute school shoes (Formal dress style)
- Sports shoes, sneakers, slides and buckled shoes are not acceptable styles of shoe for formal uniform

Secondary Physical Education Shoes - Worn with Sports Uniform

Acceptable Styles: Predominantly Black & White Sports Styles / Athletic Sneaker



Non-Acceptable: Predominantly Coloured Styles/Skate Shoes/Retro Shoes/Retro Styles/Basketball Boots



Hair – Girls (Secondary School)

- Shoulder length hair (or longer) should be pulled back or up in a style that takes it off the shoulders.
- Head bands, ribbons, hair clips and scrunchies must be plain black, plain white, navy blue or red. Hairclips, slides or combs must be black or brown. Small silver clips are permitted.
- Hair is to be out of eyes or pinned back, i.e. Fringe not to be longer than the eyebrows.
- Hair dyes, tints and rinses, where used, must be of one natural colour. Bleached hair is not permitted. Balayage, block colours or wide sections of colours are unacceptable as are brightly coloured tints.
- If girls are wearing braids, they must fit the head firmly and neatly. They must be kept neat, clean and well groomed. They must be of one natural colour.
- No extremes of hairstyles are permitted. No mohawks, dreadlocks, rats' tails, top nots, half shaved heads, multiple or unsuitable colours, tracks or cut lines are allowed.
- Use of nail polish, artificial nails and fake eyelashes are not permitted.
- Pimple (acne) patches may be worn where required for medical or skin care purposes but must be plain, unobtrusive and of a natural skin tone. Decorative, coloured or patterned skin patches are not permitted.
- Girls can wear CC or BB cream to cover facial blemishes, but are not permitted to wear foundation, mascara, eyeliner, eye shadow or coloured lip moisturisers.

Hair – Boys (Secondary School)

- Hair is to be no longer than collar length and the fringe must be out of the eyes, away from the ears and not longer than the eyebrows.
- Hair must be short, neat & tidy. Boys are not to have ponytails, hair buns or 'pinned-back' fringes.
- Hair dyes, tints and rinses, where used, must be of one natural colour. Bleached hair is not permitted.
- No extremes of hairstyles are permitted. No mohawks, half shaved heads, tracks or cut lines are allowed.
- All Secondary boys are to be clean shaven during the school day and at all College events.
- Pimple (acne) patches may be worn where required for medical or skin care purposes and must be plain, unobtrusive and a natural skin tone. Decorative, coloured or patterned patches are not permitted.

**** In matters of hairstyle and make up usage the College remains the final arbiter***

JEWELLERY

Jewellery

- Medical Alert bracelets and necklaces are permitted where a care plan has been provided. Girls are permitted to wear one pair of studs or sleepers, (gold or silver) in their ears (one in each lower ear lobe).
- Girls can use clear piercing retainers to keep multiple piercings open.
- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings apart from clear piercing retainers.
- Both boys and girls are permitted to wear a plain wristwatch, a Medic Alert bracelet or necklace if applicable.
- No other jewellery of any description is permitted.
- No body piercings including nose studs, fleshies or tattoos are allowed

Smart Watches

Students who bring smart watches to school, have 2 options:

- Store their smartwatch in a secure Salus pouch at Students Services for the day.
- Keep a locked Salus pouch with them during the day and have it unlocked at Student Services after school.

Example of Acceptable earrings for girls



Make-Up, Hair Tints/Rinses and other

- No nail polish.
- No make-up.
- No fake eyelashes
- Natural nails only (i.e. no fake, shellac, french, acrylic etc.)
- No tattoos are allowed

Prohibited Items

- Alcohol, drugs or cigarettes (including e-cigarettes)
- Any form of knife or weapon
- Chewing gum
- Laser pointers
- Any picture or written comment which may be offensive to others
- Sexually explicit magazines or videos
- Lighters, matches, firecrackers.
